

Hello Jane,

Thank you for your email last week regarding the availability of Total VET Activity and in particular disaggregated data for females.

In light of comments, **work is underway to include females as a group in the equity data visualisation product.**

In the meantime, please refer to NCVET's products on our website because they all report data by gender, i.e. for women and men, enabling users to make comparisons between the two. For example, in Table 7 of the Total VET students and courses 2014 publication information by gender on the number of program enrolments by program level, field of education and type of accreditation.

There is also an Excel pivot table (available free of charge from the NCVET Portal) from which users can make further comparisons by gender for characteristics such as age, student remoteness, provider type and delivery mode.
